- Motion by Commissioner Holland and seconded by Commissioner Barnes to approve VTCA Occupations Code 2154.202 Retail Fireworks in Martin County. All voted yes.
- Motion by Commissioner Barnes and seconded by Commissioner Holland to adopt Order regulating certain fireworks in unincorporated areas of Martin County. Prohibits fins and sticks. All voted yes.
- Motion by Commissioner Barnes and seconded by Commissioner Holland to approve Pritchard and Abbott contract for County Tax Office. All voted yes.
- Motion by Commissioner Barnes and seconded by Commissioner Holland to approve County Judge to sign Defense Agency Disposition (1033 Govt. Surplus Program) contract. All voted yes.
