- Motion by Commissioner Holland and seconded by Commissioner Barnes to approve a permit for Medallion Pipeline Company LLC: Located on CR A4200 being 6.63" in diameter, made of steel, and shall be used for the transmission of oil. To be bored and cased. 3-0. Copy on file in Clerk's office.
- Motion by Commissioner Holland and seconded by Commissioner Barnes to approve a permit for TKWR, INC. located on CR B3651 being 12" in diameter, made of poly and shall be used for the transportation of water. To be bored and cased. Commissioner Blocker abstained. 3-0 which included Judge Cox voting. Copy on file in Clerk's office.
- Motion by Commissioner Holland and seconded by Commissioner Blocker to approve payment of \$19,375.24 which is ½ of charges for landfill and chamber expenses. All voted yes. Copies on file in Clerk's Office.
- Improvements and Repairs: Judge Cox told court insurance had looked at courthouse roof. Sherriff Ingram told commissioners about problems with west gate at jail facility.
- Motion by Commissioner Barnes and seconded by Commissioner Blocker to approve VTCA Occupations Code 2154.202 Retail Fireworks in Martin County. All voted yes.
- Motion by Commissioner Barnes and seconded by Commissioner Holland to adopt Order regulating certain fireworks in unincorporated areas of Martin County. Prohibits fins and sticks. All voted yes.

- Motion by Commissioner Barnes and seconded by Commissioner Holland **not** to approve resolution for HAVA Election grants. Vote 3-0 in agreement.
- Motion by Commissioner Barnes and seconded by Commissioner Blocker to approve contract with Crane County to house inmates. All voted yes.
- Motion by Commissioner Blocker and seconded by Commissioner Barnes to return John Deere 744 loader for Road & Bridge Department. All voted yes.
- Motion by Commissioner Blocker and seconded by Commissioner Barnes to adjourn at 10:05 am. All voted yes.
